## TAPESTRY OF LIFE

On January 28, 1946, Frances Amanda Boyd was born in South Norwalk, Connecticut, to David Boyd and Dorothy Adams. She began attending Mt. Zion Baptist Church at the age of two with her family, received the Lord as her Savior at 12, and was baptized by Pastor Medley. In 1960, the family joined Calvary Baptist Church, Rev. S. J.
