# LIFE'S JOURNEY

Levi McFatten Jr. entered this life in Morrison, Florida, on January 21, 1937, welcomed by his parents, Mae Belle Johnson and Levi "Buster" McFadden. He was raised in a loving environment, and received Christ as his Savior as a young lad. Levi attended the local schools, graduating from Howard High School (formerly Howard Academy) in Ocala, FL, Class of 1957.
